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#1E-2025-0402: ANC 1E TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC SPACES BUDGET REQUESTS

WHEREAS, ANC 1E has twice voted unanimously in support of the [Georgia Avenue Bus Priority Project](#), once in [October 2023](#) and again in [October 2024](#); and

WHEREAS, ANC 1E has twice voted unanimously in support of the [Columbia Heights Crosstown Bus Priority Project](#), once in [May 2023](#) and again in [February 2024](#); and

WHEREAS, ANC 1E voted in favor of the continued disposition of Bruce Monroe and supported the development of a more permanent park at the Bruce Monroe site in [February 2024](#); and

WHEREAS, [DC is being forced to cut \\$410 million](#) from our budget, even though we have raised sufficient funds; and

WHEREAS, These infrastructure investments align with the District's sustainability goals by encouraging public transit usage, reducing vehicle emissions, and creating accessible community spaces; and

WHEREAS, Delays or cancellations to these already-planned projects would disproportionately impact vulnerable community members, including seniors, students, and residents without personal vehicles who depend on reliable public transportation; and

WHEREAS, These public infrastructure investments represent important investments in the Georgia Avenue corridor and are important to ANC 1E; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, ANC 1E urges the Council and DDOT to ensure that these projects are sufficiently funded even with the upcoming cuts:

- Georgia Avenue Bus Priority Project,
- Columbia Heights Crosstown Bus Priority Project, and
- A park at the Bruce Monroe site on Georgia Avenue; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, ANC 1E designates Commissioner Jacobson to represent the Commission in all matters relating to this Resolution. In the event the designated representative Commissioner cannot carry out their representative duties for any reason, ANC 1E authorizes the Chair to designate another Commissioner to represent the Commission in all matter relating to this Resolution.

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Certification:

At a regularly scheduled and publicly noticed meeting held on April 23, 2025, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1E considered the above resolution. With a quorum of 6 Commissioners present, the Commission voted with 6 Yeas, 0 Nays, and 0 Abstentions, to adopt the above resolution.
